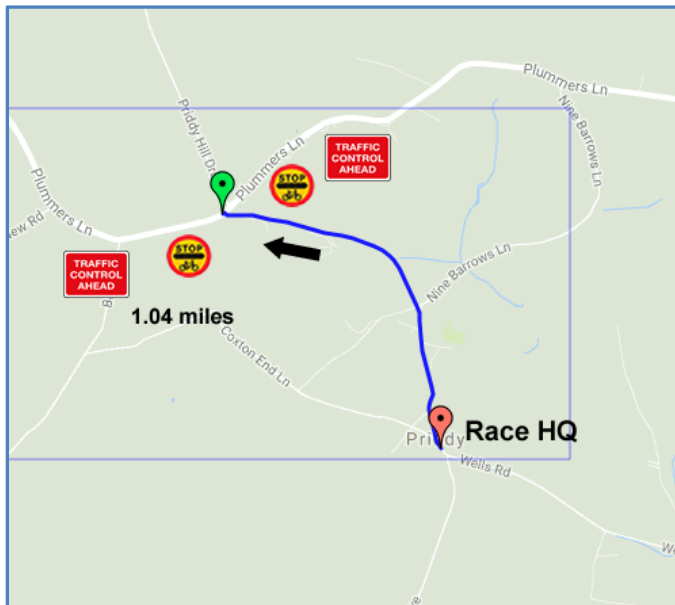

Neutralised Zone – Point 6

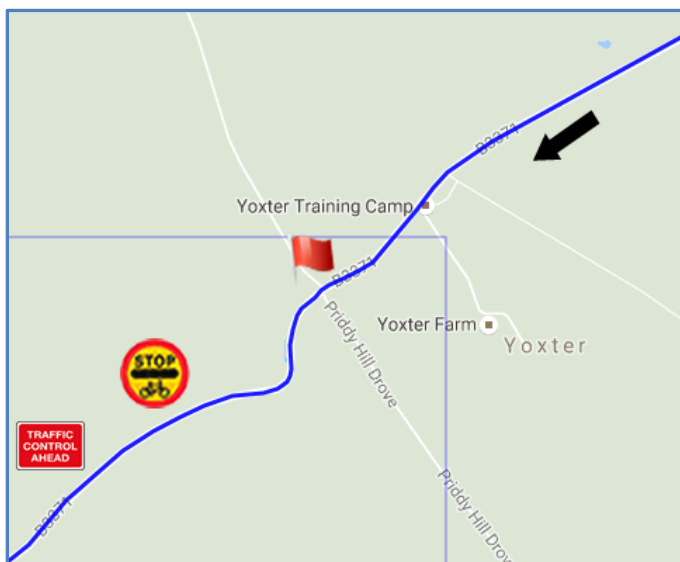


The race rollout from Race HQ will be managed by the NEG and Accredited Marshals.

Accredited Marshals from Point 3 will hold traffic whilst the race turns right onto the course at Point 6.

Accredited Marshals to then move to Point 3 in time for the race to pass on the first lap.

Marshalling Point 1



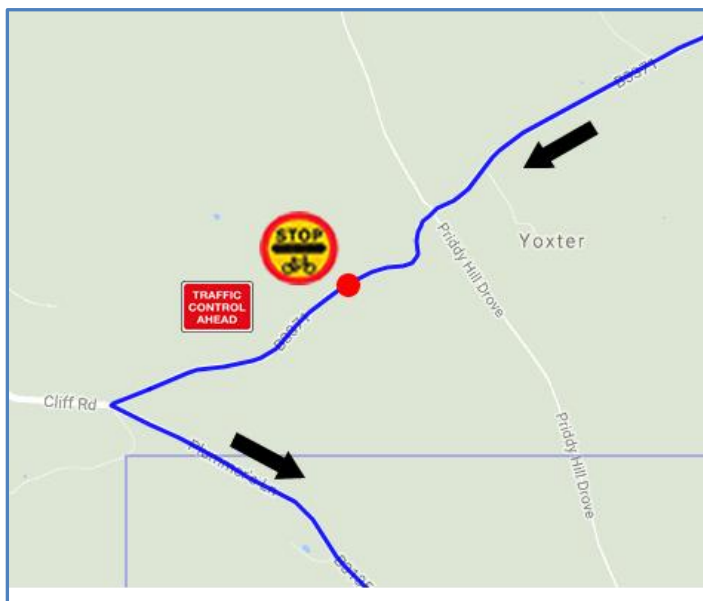

Red Flag Marshal to watch out for vehicles approaching the cross roads and ask that they wait until the race has passed.

Marshalling Point 2

Accredited Marshal to stop traffic from entering the section of narrow road containing numerous bends.

There is a field gate on the left on a straight stretch of road as you travel from Point 1 to Point 3. This is the ideal spot as you can see vehicles coming from both directions for the greatest distance.

Accredited Marshal to move to the Finish Line after the race has passed for the last time.

Marshalling Point 3

Accredited Marshals have moved to Point 3 from Point 6 after the race has cleared the Neutralised Zone.

Position Traffic Control Ahead signs before taking up position at Point 6.

Accredited Marshals to hold traffic from the west and east whilst the race negotiates the sharp corner.

Marshalling Point 4

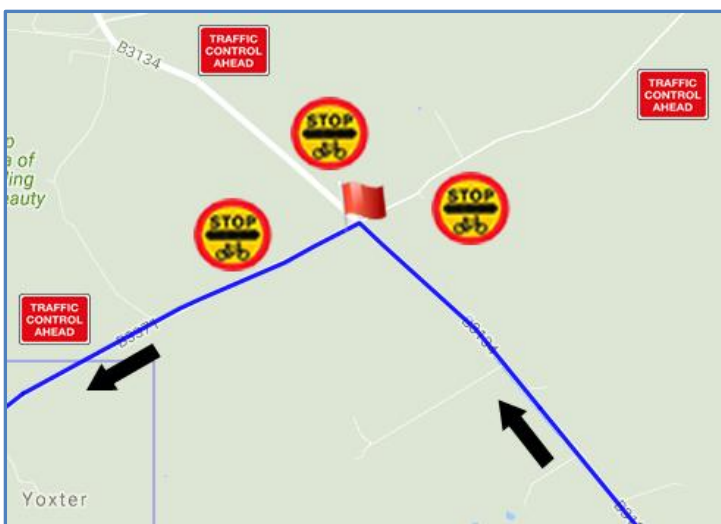

Accredited Marshals to hold traffic from the north, east and south.

If there is an extra marshal then they can be used to manage the vehicles that can build up between the marshal on the race course to the north of the junction and the junction itself. The objective is to get the vehicles clear of the junction as quickly as possible.

Accredited Marshals to hold traffic from the north, east and west whilst the race negotiates the junction.

Race Finish

Accredited Marshals to hold traffic travelling against the race whilst the finish of the race takes place.

Encourage riders to continue to the race HQ at Priddy Village Hall.
