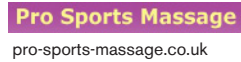

# Severn Bridge Road Race

### The Race

The race dates from the 1960's when it was organised by the late Jack Turner (an eccentric cycling genius). Crossing the first Severn Bridge it did a large circuit of Monmouthshire (South Wales), finishing in Henbury (England). Nobody objected that 90% of the race was held abroad, thus contravening the BCF rule that required the race to stay in its own division. Then it switched to a circuit through the "beautiful rolling countryside" of Avonmouth docks with the oil refineries and choking fumes of the sulphur works, where if a rider fell into one of the roadside ditches he immediately dissolved. The Olveston circuit has been used for about 20 years, however this year we have switched to a temporary circuit in Wiltshire but do hope to return to the Olveston circuit in the future.

## NEG Warning

NEG Motorcycle Marshals will be present on the race to assist in the safe passage of the race. The NEG will when safe to do so alert other road users to the presence of the race. Riders are reminded that they have an obligation to look after their own safety and obey the Highway Code. The presence of NEG Marshals does not imply that the road is closed and riders should be aware of oncoming and passing traffic and stay to the left lane of the carriageway unless otherwise instructed. NEG Marshals will make use of whistles, horns and flags to warn of danger or their presence. Riders should be particularly observant at these times. Riders should allow passage of NEG Motorcycles wherever possible and obey instructions and directions of both Static and Motorcycle Marshals.

## Notes COMPETITORS MUST READ

- Race HQ – Charlton Village Hall, open from 9.00am. Please keep clean and tidy.
- Car Parking – Official vehicles in car park in front of Village Hall, competitors/spectators in playing field behind Hall.
- PLEASE obey instructions from parking attendants. PLEASE PARK THOUGHTFULLY.
- NO PARKING NEAR THE START AND FINISH LINE.
- 10:15am – Safety Briefing for Marshals/Race Convoy/National Escort Group, meet with Chief Marshal in HQ.
- Sign on by 10:30am after which reserves will be admitted.
- 10:45am – Pre-race briefing for riders in HQ (ESSENTIAL ALL RIDERS ATTEND).
- You must observe the rules of the road at all times. Please be aware of horses and other road users.
- Only official vehicles are allowed in the race convoy. Spectators must not follow the race, you should drive the circuit in the opposite direction.
- K.O.M competition points 1st = 5, 2nd = 2, 3rd = 1. This is laps 1 to 3.
- Helmets must be worn by all riders whilst competing.
- To ride you must hold a 2014 British Cycling Race Licence.
- A neutral service vehicle may be provided that can take your wheels.
- Junior gear restriction: 9.73 metres (52x14).
- Prize presentation will be held shortly after the race finishes at the race HQ.
- Be aware of holes in the road on the section of unclassified road from Braydon Manor to Minety where river goes under the road. Area is marked on the map.

## Race Directions

### Assemble at Race HQ

Race to form up at Start/Finish line on B.4040 outside Race HQ ready for 11:00 am start. Proceed West along B.4040 out of Charlton village towards Malmesbury. Race will be de-neutralised once the race convoy is clear of Charlton village.

### Race Route:

West along B.4040 for 1.6 miles to Whychurch Roundabout at junction with A.429 (M). CAUTION. Take first exit LEFT (M) onto A.429 Malmesbury By Pass dual carriageway. Race to keep to inner (lefthand) lane only. Follow By Pass for 1 mile to next roundabout (M), keeping to left hand lane only (any riders crossing into outer lane will be liable to immediate disqualification). Take first exit LEFT (M) into B.4042 towards Brinkworth and Wootton Bassett. Follow B.4042 for 8.3 miles through Brinkworth village (CAUTION), KOM is approx 0.5 miles beyond Brinksworth. Then on to Ballard's Ash junction approximately 1 mile before reaching Wootton Bassett. Turn LEFT (M) onto B.4696 for 2 miles to Purton Crossroads. Turn LEFT (M) onto unclassified road, and in 2/3rds mile follow road around sharp righthand bend to continue for a further 2 miles up The Common (unclassified) to junction with B.4040 at Minety. Turn LEFT (M) onto B.4040 and continue for 4.4 miles to complete lap at Start/Finish line outside race HQ in Charlton village.

Lap Distance: 20.0 miles / 32.1 kms, estimated lap time approx 45-50 mins. Full Race Distance: 3 laps, 60 miles / 96 kms, estimated duration approx 2hrs 15mins to 2hrs 30mins.
