Start at HQ, Finish at Village Green, The Crescent, Old Down

### The Race

The race dates from the 1960's when it was organised by the late Jack Turner (an eccentric cycling genius). Crossing the first Severn Bridge it did a large circuit of Monmouthshire (South Wales), finishing in Henbury (England). Nobody objected that 90% of the race was held abroad, thus contravening the BCF rule that required the race to stay in its own division. Then it switched to a circuit through the "beautiful rolling countryside" of Avonmouth docks with the oil refineries and choking fumes of the sulphur works, where if a rider fell into one of the roadside ditches he immediately dissolved. This year we return again to our original Olveston circuit which was our previous home for more than 25 years

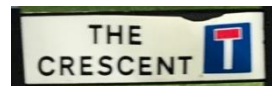

## IMPORTANT NOTES: Competitors, Officials and Marshals MUST READ

1. You must first read the **Covid Briefing Notes** that have been sent to you by the race organiser which accompanies this programme.
2. No riders, officials or volunteers should attend the event if they or anyone they live with has Covid-19 symptoms, is self-isolating or has had a positive test in the past 10 days.
3. Race HQ – Marlwood School, is open from 9.00. Please observe social distancing.
4. Sign-on will be outside, your licence will be checked but not retained. Collect your number at sign-on, it does NOT have to be returned.
5. Toilets are available and there is an IN/OUT route. No more than two people in the toilet at one time and you must wear a mask when using toilets.
6. There are no changing facilities, you should arrive self sufficient or use your vehicle.
7. Car Parking – Plenty of parking available in front of the HQ and on side and on rear football field. Officials vehicles area will be marked off near Car Park exit. Please obey instructions from parking attendants. PLEASE PARK THOUGHTFULLY.
8. NO PARKING NEAR THE START AND FINISH LINE. Parking is allowed at the top of Old Down Hill in Car Park of the Queen Alexandra Memorial Pavilion. (QAMP).
9. 9:30 and 12:30 – Safety Briefing for Marshals/Race Convoy/ National Escort Group, meet with Chief Marshal in HQ Car Park.
10. Sign on by 10:00 and 13:00 and after which reserves will be admitted.
11. 10:15 and 13:15 – Pre-race briefing for riders in Car Park (ESSENTIAL ALL RIDERS ATTEND YOU CAN BE DISQUALIFIED IF YOU MISS IT). Riders must assemble outside HQ, BEHIND race convoy when instructed to do so.
12. You must observe the rules of the road at all times. Please be aware of horses and other road users.
13. Please do not park on grass verges where there are flowers growing. This will upset the local residents and jeopardise our use of the circuit in the future.
14. If the race is slowed because of traffic you must never pass the lead car. Any rider that does so will be immediately disqualified.
15. Only official vehicles are allowed in the race convoy. Spectators must not follow the race, you should drive the circuit in the opposite direction.
16. K.O.M competition points 1st = 5, 2nd = 2, 3rd = 1. Nat B race: laps 2 to 7, Reg A race: laps 2 to 5 at top of Old Down Hill. Points also go towards overall KOM prize.
17. Helmets must be worn by all riders whilst competing. To ride you must hold a 2021 British Cycling Race Licence.
18. A neutral service vehicle will be provided that can take your wheels. The service vehicle CANNOT draft you back onto the race at any time.
19. Junior gear restriction is 7.93 metres (52x14). Riders must perform their own gear check under supervision. Please check before the event or you may not be allowed to ride. ## Circuit Description:

Depart race HQ at Marlwood School turn RT onto circuit, Vattingsone Lane B4461, neutralised for 0.5km. Race starts. Continue on B4461 down fast descent and on through Elberton Village. After 2.5km turn LT off Redhill Lane, onto Aust Rd (unclassified) to Olveston, road narrows in Olveston, then on through Tockington at 6.5km, road narrows, turn LT on to Old Down Hill, KOM at top of Hill, then turn RT at summit and cross roads at 7.5km. On to finish line after a further 1km, The Crescent, Village Green about 50m before bus shelter. Continue on circuit, after 2km turn LT at Cross Roads (former Cross Hands Inn, Alveston) onto Vattingsone Lane B4461 to pass HQ and complete lap. **Races finish after crossing the FINISH line on the 6th (Reg A) and 10th (Nat B) occasion.** Lap distance 11km.
