The Race.

The race dates from the 1960's when it was organised by the late Jack Turner (an eccentric cycling genius). Crossing the first Severn Bridge it did a large circuit of Monmouthshire (South Wales), finishing in Henbury (England). Nobody objected that 90% of the race was held abroad, thus contravening the BCF rule that required the race to stay in it's own division. Then it switched to a circuit through the "beautiful rolling countryside" of Avonmouth docks with the oil refineries and choking fumes of the Phil-black sulphur works, where if a rider fell in to one of the roadside ditches he immediately dissolved. The present circuit has been used for about 20 years and is a 10.5km triangular circuit with a short sharp climb.

- Race HQ - Olveston Sports & Social Club, open from 8:30am (Please keep it clean & tidy).
- 10:15am - Marshals/Race Convoy/National Escort Group meet Chief Marshal Graham Moore for briefing.
- Sign on by 10:30am, after which reserves will be admitted.
- 10:40am - Pre-race briefing for riders in HQ (ESSENTIAL ALL RIDERS ATTEND).
- For Safety observe the rules of the road. Horses with riders use this circuit.
- Spectators please park thoughtfully and only follow the race in the opposite direction.
- NO PARKING ON RIGHT HAND BEND AFTER TOP OF PRIME HILL.
- K.O.M. competition points 1st = 5, 2nd = 2, 3rd = 1 (ON LAPS 1 TO 9 ONLY).
- Prize presentation will be held shortly after the finish at race HQ.
- Helmets must be worn by all riders whilst competing.
- To Ride you must hold a 2010 BC licence!
- No service vehicles in race convoy. Available service points are highlighted.
- No unofficial vehicles in the race convoy.
- Junior gear restriction: 9.73 meters (52x14).

Race Directions

Assemble at Race HQ - Neutralized to Start/Finish Line.

Race starts... Straight on 1.5km... Sharp left at X roads on to B4661 (A) straight on for 4km... To very tight double left turn (B) in to Aust Road... Straight on to Olveston Village, narrow road and parked cars (CAUTION)... Straight on to Tockington Village... Left (C) onto Prime Hill (Old Down Hill)... CAUTION right turn top of Hill (D) 0.5km to finish line... 10 Laps
